Spending a day travelling round the VELOCITY festival?  
Starting in Barrow on Saturday? Then this is the itinerary for you!

## What tickets will you need?

A cheap day return or other transport method to get to and from Barrow-in-Furness Station.  
A Lakes Day Ranger ticket, which will get you all around the bay, on whichever trains you like, all day for £15 or less (adult fare £15 – for further info ask at any station or visit the national rail website [www.nationalrail.co.uk](http://www.nationalrail.co.uk))

Starting in Barrow-in-Furness, visit The Mall on Duke Street to see Rich White's [Vigilance](#) installation (open 24 hours). If you're an early starter you could also have time to explore one of the Walney Island walks – guides available from The Dock Museum and other tourist locations in Barrow. Seiko Mikami's [Desire of Codes](#) installation is at The Dock Museum (open from 11:00 at weekends).

Then make your way to the Station for your first train journey:

**Depart Barrow-in-Furness 11:16. Arrive Ulverston 11:34.**  
**OR Depart Barrow-in-Furness 12:22. Arrive Ulverston 11:37.**

At Ulverston make your way to Lanternhouse for the [SUPERVELOCITY](#) group show.

While you're in Ulverston why not visit the following local businesses before heading back to the station for your next train:

**Depart Ulverston 13:15. Arrive Carnforth 13:49.**  
**OR Depart Ulverston 14:36. Arrive Carnforth 15:04.**

At Carnforth Station head to Furness and Midland Hall to see [The Endless Forest](#).

**Depart Carnforth 15:26. Arrive Lancaster 16:20.**  
**OR Depart Carnforth 15:38. Arrive Lancaster 16:32.**

In Lancaster take a walk down to The Edge Gallery on King Street to see [just](#) by ~in the fields. You'll also have time to explore this historic market town, before catching your final train of the day:

**Depart Lancaster 17:16. Arrive Barrow-in-Furness 18:21.**
